Bachelor's Educational Program
Policy Governing Student Status Termination for Poor Academic Performance

*Approved by the Faculty of Business, Technology, and Education
Board Resolution #48, March 16, 2023.*

1. Student status is terminated in case a student fails to obtain a credit three times in the same compulsory course offered by the bachelor's educational programs at the School of Technology, Faculty of Business, Technology, and Education, Ilia State University. The policy applies to the bachelor's programs and their mandatory components, as specified in Appendix #1. **(Appendix N1)**.
2. The aforementioned policy will come into force **from the spring semester of the academic year 2022-2023** and will apply to all cases that occur after its adoption. The policy will be posted permanently on the Ilia State University website and in the electronic selection system Argus.
3. According to this policy, a student with a terminated status is not permitted to participate in internal mobility but will maintain their right to external mobility.
4. Upon the semester completion, the Faculty of Business, Technology and Education dean is obliged to submit to the rector a list of students, subject to termination of status under the said policy.
